Deadline for submitting an application is 12th of November.

Furthermore, students who have already completed an application from their home university to study abroad must also complete the Grenoble INP application form.

- Relevant documents to be uploaded :
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Motivation letter
 - Copy of last degree obtained
 - Past courses followed at Home University
 - List of courses currently taking in Home University
 - Academic transcript of records
 - Language certificate (available certificate form in the application form)
 - Recommendation letter
 - Learning agreement (available model in the application form)
 - Nomination letter from Home University
- Important informations for non European students : They must apply as soon as possible to the CEF on-line procedure in order to obtain a student visa. It is compulsory for 43 countries : Algeria, Argentina, Benin, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Burundi Cameroon, Chile, China, Colombia, Comoros, the Republic of the Congo, South Korea, Ivory Coast, Egypt, United States, Gabon, Guinea, Haïti, India, Indonesia, Iran, Japan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Madagascar, Mali, Morocco, Mauritius, Mauritania, Mexico, Nigeria, Peru, Senegal, Democratic Republic of Congo, Russia, Senegal, Singapore, Taiwan, Togo, Tunisia, Turkey and Vietnam. - Housing: Students who received the acknowledgment of receipt of their complete application form will receive a login and password from the beginning of October to begin the housing process with ISSO.

Deadlines : From October 1st to November 15th 2019

- Insurance: In France, the healthcare system generally takes care of most healthcare costs. **Subscription to health insurance is mandatory (upon they arrival) for stays of more than 3 months**, unless there is a bilateral agreement between France and your country of origin. This is the case for all member states of the European Union, European Economic Area, as well as Switzerland and Quebec: steps are thus to be taken before your arrival in France.
